nformation security remains a high priority in the minds of the public and the regulators and consequently concerns over cybersecurity and security breaches remain important areas of risk. Since the adoption of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act in 1999 (GLBA), information security breaches have unfortunately become commonplace but are, if anything, becoming more terrifying. Breaches of data systems can expose a financial institution to regulatory criticism, civil liability and reputation risk.

The banking regulators have long understood that security breaches are inevitable and while efforts must be made to prevent them, the real focus of examiners seems to be not on prevention but on the response.
